



Lineworker Program Information and Timeline

Thank you for your expressed interest in the Electrical/Utility Lineworker Certificate program at Lansing Community College. Please review the information below as well as the curriculum guide and current program costs.

Application Requirements:

- Must possess a high school diploma, GED, or provide a letter from your high school of expected graduation.
- Must have minimum of level 4 in Reading, Writing, and Math. Assessments can be done at any LCC campus.
http://www.lcc.edu/assessment/on_campus/cpt.aspx. Allow about 1 hour for each test.
- Be eligible for a Michigan Commercial Driver's License (CDL). Applicants will submit a driving record for review during the application process.
- Must be 18 years old prior to participating in the Lineworker 4-Day Orientation Class (ELTE 270).
- Applicants must pass a pre-screen drug test during the application process.
- Disclose any felony or misdemeanor convictions that may impact employability and thus can impact program department approval.
- Willing to work at heights exceeding 60-feet.
- Physically able to carry 50 lbs of tools.
- Applicants must weigh less than 300 lbs. (Based on weight restriction of the safety equipment)
